

# **Ground School – CPL Course (with IF)**

# CL-CPL

#### **Course Overview**

This course will provide you with the ground training and exams that you require to obtain credits for all the **Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) Theoretical Subjects** required. This course is identical to the knowledge training required for an **Instrument Flight (IF)** rating. (If only an IF rating is required, a certain subject do not apply. Similarly, a CPL WITHOUT an IF rating also do not require certain knowledge training – Refer to Training Plan below)

## **Enrolment Requirements**

Must have a valid PPL licence

# **Training Plan**

- 198 Hours of Classroom Lectures on the following eight theory subjects:
  - Meteorology
  - o Flight Planning
  - o Radio Aids
  - Navigation
  - Air law and Procedures (Procedures only in case of a CPL with IF rating)
  - Instruments
  - o Human Performance
  - Aircraft Technical and General (Not required if only an IF rating is needed)
- CAA conducted exams for all 8 theoretical subjects (75% pass mark)

#### **Course Duration**

This course covers all eight subjects, typically over a nine week period and is conducted several times a year. (Refer to our website at <a href="www.simflight.co.za">www.simflight.co.za</a> for the latest course dates) The student will also be required to do home studying prior to presenting him/herself for the exam.

<u>Note:</u> Although you may rewrite each exam multiple times (after a prescribed waiting period) you may also be required to attend remedial classes before you will be allowed to rewrite after a failed exam. CAA requires all subjects to be passed within 18 month from passing the first subject.
